PENNSYLVANIAEXPRESS stalked the pace from along the inside through the turn, reached contention late then drew off under urging. DECOLATOR was slow early, saved ground on the turn while advancing steadily and finished second best. A KISS IN THE PARK was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn then rallied mildly. MONTECORE vied for the lead from along the inside, then drew off on the turn and weakened late. THREE POINT TICKET was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch. TRIPPED OVER showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn then faltered. CAPIXABA vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the turn, then flattened out late.
