TRIFECTA moved closer leaving the turn and loomed boldly near the furlong pole then drove clear. TROPICAL KELLY was forwardly placed and responded well in the drive to gain the place. DERBY VOW was outrun to the stretch then responded well in drive between horses but was too late. MAGIC MISCHIEF, never far back, responded well in the drive. SEMINARY DAN moved to the lead on the turn then faded in the final furlong. AMAZIN WEBB SNYDER lacked the needed closing response. ARTILLERY EXCHANGE failed to be a threat. DAITON'S DESTINY was outrun. FIFTY FRAME was outrun. HAZAAM'S ADVANTAGE dueled for the early lead and tired.
