SHANIA LASS stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then rallied late and was up in the final strides. CALL DENIED was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, angled inward at the top of the stretch and closed willingly. CRYING FOR LOVE pressed the pace from the inside through the turn then lacked a late response. TOO MUCH BARBIE raced three wide on the turn, rallied late to finish well. COZY FANNIE was three wide on the turn but lacked a rally. CERTAINLY SIR lacked speed and showed little. DESIGNED set the pace with a clear lead, then broke down in the stretch.
