DEVIL ON DECK showed early speed inside, came outside entering the turn, dueled on even terms through the lane but was caught late. BRAD'S ON PATROL showed speed inside from the outside but faltered. SEATTLE'S FORTUNE wasn't far back, raced wide around the turn and gained through the lane. FOR A FEE was slow leaving the gate then was unhurried early, stayed inside around the turn, angled out between horses for the drive and gained late. GOLDEN WAY made up some ground without threatening. PAWLING showed early speed then weakened. SNOWBALL KING had early position inside then tired. HANNA'S KAT took command just before going a furlong, raced two wide around the turn and stopped.
