

FOR A FEE stayed out from the rail around the turn and gained mildly through the lane. ANCHOR ALERT was slow from the gate then was unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn and gained late. C F SLEW OF STORMS raced two wide between rivals and made up some ground. CODYS BIRTHDAY raced wide around the turn while outrun. SHOOBIE showed early speed inside then stopped. SNOWBALL KING had position three wide to the stretch then stopped. MINTED AGE stopped. WACO RULER angled to the rail with the early lead then stopped in the lane.
