GINNYGIN set the pace from the start, saved ground with a clear lead throughout, then finished under urging. SILVER MOMENT was unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn, then closed ground fast and finished second best. CELEBRATING SARAH was slow early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. HICKORY GRAY pressed the pace early, saved ground through the second turn, then flattened out in the stretch. BANKER BAILOUT lacked speed, raced two wide on the far turn, then was outrun late.
