GINNYGIN showed speed, moved to the front just before a quarter, raced wide around the turn and faltered. JUICY LUCY was prominent between rivals into the final furlong then weakened. SUNSET HEIGHTS wasn't far back between rivals into the turn then weakened in the lane. EIGHTYFIVE S was prominent between rivals early, stayed out from the rail around the turn then weakened. NICTATE was slow from the gate and wide into the stretch while no factor. CHOSIN RESERVOIR was no factor. MOON OVER MALIBU steadied while not far back along the rail nearing the end of the backstretch then flattened out. GREEK ADVANTAGE broke sharply for the early lead, angled to the rail on the turn and stopped.
