## Footnotes

THREE QUARTER TOUT was never far back, raced along the inside through the turn, then contended in mid stretch and drew off under urging. DEANOGUSKA was close up from the start, raced along the inside through the turn, then made a late bid to be second best. ARE YOU SERIOUS was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, angled outward at the top of the stretch and rallied mildly. ME THE SEA AND G T was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly. KIERNAN'S LEGACY vied for the early lead from along the inside, drew clear on the turn then was headed in mid stretch and gave way. FAVORITE FLASHBACK was void of early speed, raced inside on the turn, angled outward at the top of the stretch and made a mild bid in the stretch. MAGNIFICENT SKY raced three wide on the turn, then angled to the inside but lacked a rally. VALID OCEAN PASS vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the turn, then faltered in the stretch. CAPTAIN KALI vied for the early lead, raced two wide through the turn, then faded in the lane. HIDDEN BAY was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then flattened out in the stretch. PENSYLVANIAEXPRESS showed brief speed, raced along the four path on the turn then was outrun.
