NEW PARADIGM vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide through the far turn, then gave way after a long drive. POCO was close up and three wide on the second turn then made a mild bid. STEEP SHEET was never far back, raced four wide on the second turn and failed to sustain a bid. WORTHY SOLDIER vied for the lead from along the inside to the far turn then faded. GOLDEN NICOLAS was close up early, saved ground to the far turn then weakened. RIVERCARD was three wide on the far turn and failed to menace. SUNSHINE SCOTT vied for the early lead from along the inside then flattened out on the far turn. LEENMEALONE was close up early then faded on the far turn.
