LITTLE MARSHALL stalked the pace from along the inside, then angled out on the far turn, gained command and finished under urging. WINTER ESCAPE was never far back, raced three wide on the far turn then made a late bid. PUDDLE TIME was slow early, raced three wide on the far turn and closed ground willingly from the outside. COURT VERDICT was void of early speed, raced three wide on the second turn then made a belated rally. GOLDEN NICOLAS was three wide on the second turn and raced evenly. RANDOLPH ATTHELOOP set the pace with a clear lead through the backstretch, was headed on the far turn then faded. CRAFTY ACCOUNT pressed the pace from along the inside, reached contention on the second turn then tired from early efforts. FIRE FOX stalked the early pace, was three wide on the far turn and faltered in the stretch. ACHILL pressed the early pace, was two wide on the second turn then flattened out. BOOKLE BO trailed the field.
