SMART AGENDA was rated early while not far back of the dueling leaders, moved up three wide on the final turn, drew clear nearing the final sixteenth then widened under urging. GO BROWNS dueled two wide early, fell back on the backstretch, moved three wide to a short lead midway on the final turn then weakened in the lane. CLASS CONCERN lagged early, made a wide run into the stretch to get closer then flattened out. SHABANG SHABANG was caught wide while showing speed around the first turn, dueled to the stretch then stopped. GOLDEN WAY showed speed three wide, angled to the rail nearing the end of the backstretch while dueling then stopped in the lane. GOLDEN NICOLAS was no factor. THUNDER QUEST stopped.
