MORNING THEFT pressed the pace three and four wide, gained the lead in the upper stretch, led until the final strides. PHIL THE BRIT off a step slow, moved up four and five wide, finished strongly. BALIAN prompted the issue three wide, dropped to the rail along the backstretch, lacked a closing bid. TEMPLAR'S CUP within striking distance from the inside, failed to respond. STORM DOOR set the pace on a clear lead, remained a factor on the turn, weakened in the drive. FIT FOR A FIGHT was used up after a half, three wide.
