R J'S PROSPECT settled, rallied the rail to gain a short advantage leaving the furlong grounds and held. SATELLITE BEACH dueled two wide early, moved clear on the final turn, responded when challenged by the winner and gave way grudgingly. AWESOME CHARLIE stayed well out from the rail but lacked a rally. GREG GOT EVEN lagged early, swung out leaving the final turn and finished willingly. BELONGS TO SHEILA was slow to settle, raced three wide around the final turn and gained mildly. FORT DENMARK made a mild two wide run on the final turn then flattened out. TIME LIMIT was outrun two wide. CODE BLUE dueled inside into the final turn then tired. MALIBU RHYTHM was outrun.
