HENRY TWO U vied for the lead, raced along the inside on the second turn, then faltered in the stretch. CLOSING MAN was through early, raced three wide on the far turn and was never a threat. LOOK OF HOPE was close up early, raced inside on the second turn, then faltered in the stretch and was outrun. EASY GALLOP was unprepared for the start and lost jockey.
