MORETHANASTAR was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied late and drew clear under urging. SAND SLOUGH was slow early, raced three wide on the turn then rallied mildly. MOONSHADOW GOLD vied for the early lead, drew off on the turn then was outfinished. VICTORIOUS RECALL pressed the pace from along the inside into the turn, then lacked a late response. JOHNNY OLA saved ground but was not a threat. DEER DANNY BOY stalked the pace from the three path into the turn then faded. WITHOUT A RING vied for the lead from the inside into the turn, then faltered in the drive. SNOWBALL KING lacked speed and showed little. CLASSY LAUREN raced three wide on the turn and was outrun.
