TOMORROW'S TALE pressed the pace from along the inside, reached contention on the turn then entered into a long drive and was outfinished at the wire. HIHOPESMPTYPOCKETS was close up from the start, raced five wide on the turn, then made a late bid. SMALL GIANT vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, dueled in the stretch then gave way late. RED PETE prompted the pace from the four path through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. FOREST JUSTICE showed good early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch. VILLAGE ROMEO stalked the early pace, raced three wide on the turn then faltered late. GHOSTWRITER showed brief speed, raced inside on the turn, then was through after a half. SILVER CRAFT vied for the early lead, raced along the inside on the turn then gave way and was outrun.
