TOMORROW'S TALE had position three wide, was carried wide into the stretch and tired. PERFECT GENTLEMAN lagged following a slow break then was forced wide on the turn. DAPPER DEVIL fell back from tight quarters along the rail entering the turn then failed to menace. CLAM BAKE was carried wide on the turn then tired. RED PETE pulled up early on the turn then was walked off the track.
