DEPUTY'S HONOR set the pace while saving ground, led throughout and finished under urging. CASE NOTES was close up from the start, raced inside on the turn, then made a late bid for place. VAN LEROY pressed the pace from the three path through the turn then weakened late. EXECUTIVE SHANE pressed the pace from the two path through the turn then tired. CREATIVE MIND stalked the pace from the two path then faded in the stretch. STORM RISING failed to menace. WAVE LAND SQUIRE was three wide on the turn and not a threat. THUNDER N BOLD lacked speed and was outrun.
