Footnotes

WYNN WILLIE WYNN showed speed, stayed out from the rail once clear early on the backstretch, responded gamely when challenged in early stretch and was up on the nod. FLYBIRD was unhurried early, was sent up the outside on the backstretch, drew even outside the winner entering the final furlong and just missed in a game effort. MOUNTAIN CLIMBER raced inside the winner to the stretch, remained in good position into the far turn then stopped and outlasted the others. FORT DENMARK lagged two wide to the stretch then passed tired ones. MONTY CAT stayed out from the rail while unhurried then faded. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE stayed well out from the inside while outrun. DOMESTIC AFFAIR stayed along the rail and stopped. SHOW THE FLAG was outrun three wide.
