READY FOR DUTY, a step slow to break, rushed up for the lead inside to set a pressured pace approaching the three eighths pole and dug in under hardy stretch handling to hold on. JESSIE'S BOY pressured the winner two deep and dug in a game relentless stretch factor to chase that one home. TAPIS MAGIQUE settled off the early pace outside, bid saving ground toward the five sixteenths pole but leveled off near the rail in late stretch. SPIKEAVELLIAN gave chase about the five path then leveled off in the lane. CAPE SABLE pressed the pace three wide to the five sixteenths pole, dropped back rounding the turn and proved empty in the stretch. KING CHIECA, in close early pursuit outside, saved ground on the turn. CITY GENIUS, shuffled back at the start, gave distant chase while saving ground. NIMO was no factor saving ground. UNUSUAL LAZ gave distant chase while racing wide.
