HITEC DAVE was hustled clear before the first turn, angled in to be out from the rail and was kept to task. THAT'S SHOWBIZ lagged inside, angled out sharply after seven furlongs while rallying and finished willingly. ECHSTEIN VILLAGE wasn't far back two wide between horses and weakened. MIA POPPY pressed outside the winner for about three quarters then tired. TRUE HEAVEN was steadied in tight between horses midway on the backstretch, angled to the rail entering the far turn then tired. QUARTERBACK SNEAK was outrun. MISSION GAP wasn't far back outside to the far turn then tired. CATFIVE was close up inside to the backstretch then stopped.
