FULL N SASSY set the pace from the start, saved ground and led throughout, then finished under vigorous encouragement. PELICAN LAKE was never far back, raced along the inside on the last turn, then was no match for the winner in the drive. STOOPEPDOUS DIVA pressed the pace early, raced along the inside through the second turn, then lacked a late response. SILVER PARTNER was unhurried early, raced along the two path on the far turn, then made a mild bid late. FULL STORM stalked the pace early, raced two wide on the last turn, then weakened in the stretch. MARK UP TINY was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then failed to sustain her bid. VICTORIOUS DEVIL prompted the early pace, raced three wide on the far turn, then faltered in the stretch. SUGAR SHARK lacked speed, saved ground then was pulled up at the 1/4 pole and vanned off.
