TANGO was sent up the rail to a short lead midway on the backstretch, remained prominent to the stretch then stopped. ALPHABET JAMERICA made the early pace outside, raced three wide around the turn, ran out entering the stretch and stopped. BILLET'S BABY was making a run to vie into the turn when she went bad, pulled up lame and was vanned off.
