Footnotes

IT'S CLOSING TIME angled in after clearing rivals in the run to the first turn, was joined by DANGEROUS VIXEN after a quarter mile and got into a prolonged duel, drifted out brushing DANGEROUS VIXEN who in turn made contact with DEFY GRAVITY in upper stretch, was straightened away with the right stick, turned away a rail challenge by DECO ROCKS a sixteenth out then held firm. DEFY GRAVITY stalked the dueling leaders four wide, ranged up to be a serious threat leaving the three sixteenths marker, was brushed and floated out in upper stretch, recovered and battled back gamely. DECO ROCKS steadied off the heels of IT'S CLOSING TIME when keen to go entering the backstretch, relaxed soon after and stalked the pace, got through along the rail in upper stretch, lodged a menacing bid in mid stretch then flattened out. TEA PARTY GAL settled early, advanced along the rail around the final turn but needed more late. DANGEROUS VIXEN moved three wide to collar IT'S CLOSING TIME around the first turn, dueled, was brushed and floated out into a rival in upper stretch then weakened. DO THE CHARLESTON was steadied back from between rivals soon after the break, lost ground four to five wide chasing then gave way. BURST AWAY, ridden along four wide pursuing the dueling leaders, dropped back around the final turn. Following a stewards' inquiry and objection by the rider of DANGEROUS VIXEN, IT'S CLOSING TIME was disqualified from first and placed fifth for causing interference in upper stretch.
