E. ESPEE was unhurried early, raced inside on the turn then rallied late and drew off under urging. COCKEYED COWBOY vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then drew clear in the stretch but gave way late. NINETY FIVE SOUTH vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then weakened in the drive. UNCLE CARM raced in the second flight on the backstretch, was three wide through the turn then lacked a rally. SOUTHERN NIGHTS was slow early, raced along the four path on the turn then angled in entering the stretch but was not a threat. NANA'S WINNER vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then faded in the stretch. CRUISE DIRECTOR lacked speed, raced along the five path on the turn and was never a factor. JUST ASK ROBERT lacked speed, raced inside on the turn and trailed throughout.
