CUBAN DEVIL was never far back inside, steadied sharply entering the turn, remained along the rail, was sent to challenge entering the final furlong then drew out. TUCKED IN FRONT pressed the early leader outside, raced the three path around the turn, opened a short lead in early stretch then couldn't contain the winner. UNCLE CARM was hustled to stay close early, raced three wide around the turn then gained outside late. SHARP DEFRERE was slow to settle then made up ground along the rail through the lane. LARRY OF LYNN was slow leaving the gate then was sent up inside, came out two wide on the turn and continued evenly between horse through the lane. PUBLIC SECRET wasn't far back outside early, angled wide on the turn then tired. ECSTATIC DREAMER was slow to settle, swung wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SILENT PUNCH made the early pace inside, came out from the rail on the turn then faded from between horses through the lane.
