TUXEDO RAY stalked the early leader two wide then was carried far out through the lane by that one and couldn't stay with the winner late. SILENT PUNCH was sent clear from the inside nearing the end of the backstretch, stayed close to the rail around the turn then drifted badly through the lane and faltered. RONNIE JAMES JR wasn't far back early, stayed out from the rail around the turn and lacked a closing response. TRIPLE A. RATING was unhurried between horses, angled to the rail on the turn and lacked a rally. ST JOHN'S GOSPEL raced three wide in an even effort. TRIBUTE broke slowly and fell far back early.
