DOWNTOWN GIRL showed speed between rivals, opened a clear lead into the turn, remained out from the rail into the stretch and gave way grudgingly. HOBOKEN HONEY was slow early, angled to the rail then finished with good energy. CARRY THE TORCH wasn't far back while racing well out from the rail then weakened in the lane. PINK PRINCESS moved to vie in the four path on the turn then tired. ONEMORESWEETKISS was hustled early, came out two wide on the turn and stopped. KENTUCKY HANNAH broke down and fell nearing the turn then was humanely euthanized.
