NASTAR MEDALLIST broke slowly, hugged the rail leaving the backstretch, steadied entering the turn, saved ground on the turn, eased out for the drive, angled to the five path in mid stretch, closed outside horses and drove clear. ROXBURY ROCKET chased the pace three deep around the turn, challenged for the lead near the sixteenth pole and was out finished. SO SERENE chased the pace outside BRIDGE NIGHT, remained prominent to deep stretch then faded. LITTLE ITALY circled the turn three deep, was four wide entering the stretch, was floated out in upper stretch and closed the gap late. GATOR GONE WILD hugged the rail, angled out near the sixteenth pole and needed more. ONEMORESWEETKISS, a forward factor early, was two deep on the turn, floated out in upper stretch and failed to rally. BRIDGE NIGHT (GB) sped to the early lead, saved ground setting the pace and gave way in mid stretch. BACKYARD BOOGIE raced in the two path on the turn and was not a factor. TONI WITH AN I broke slowly, trailed and was very wide in upper stretch.
