NEVER STOP LOOKING rated kindly two wide between rivals through the opening half mile, edged closer when given his cue mid turn, angled four wide for clear sailing soon after, ranged up to join rivals past the quarter pole, drifted in and brushed TOP OF THE PODIUM after taking over in mid stretch, corrected to go clear then held firm under a drive. FACE THE FIRE set a slow pressured pace towards the rail, dueled from the head of the stretch to mid stretch, brushed with TOP OF THE PODIUM in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker, kept on gamely and regained the place. TOP THE PODIUM prompted the pace two wide, moved between rivals to challenge mid turn, dueled, was brushed by the winner leaving the eighth pole, drifted in a bit and brushed FACE THE FIRE near the sixteenth marker and kept on gamely to the wire. BIG BAD IKE lagged back while saving ground, was under urging leaving the far turn, moved off the rail mid turn, swung five wide for the drive and finished with good energy. CHIEF THUNDERCLOUD bobbled inward at the break to be away last, regrouped and pulled his way to contention inside rivals, tracked the issue around the turn, eased out for the drive, made a run leaving the eighth pole then flattened out. OUTHAUL stalked the pace three wide, bid to threaten mid turn, forced the issue to upper stretch then gave way. VERY LUCKY , four deep in range to the half mile marker, failed to kick on when asked. NO SHENANIGANS , forwardly placed three wide between runners for a half mile, was under urging mid turn, lacked a response and faded.
