TRIBUTE hesitated in the gate at the break then was taken outside, swung wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside the winner. NINETY FIVE SOUTH pressed the early leader, moved two wide to command into the turn and gave way through the final sixteenth. TAP CHAP wasn't far back outside but lacked a response. PHOSPHOR lagged early while racing well out from the rail and failed to menace. WE ARE DUE made the pace along the rail to the turn and stopped in the lane. MALICIOUS had position three wide, gave his best on the turn then stopped in the lane. WICKET EWOK stopped inside.
