AGATHA K vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then drew off while under urging. ESPRESSO ROYALE pressed the pace from along the inside on the turn, angled outward but was no match for the winner in the drive. SEVEN DEADLY SINS vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then gave way in the stretch. RUN PATTY RUN was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then weakened in the lane. RUTTZY TUTTZY vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faded late. SPEEDWAY MONKEY was slow early, saved ground on the turn and was not a factor. ANGELIC LIONESS was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn and was never a threat. QUEEN MERCURY was four wide on the turn and through after a half.
