Footnotes

SINGING MY WAY showed speed two wide, took over entering the backstretch, drew out on the far turn and held under brisk handling. VERY LUCKY was unhurried when caught wide around the first turn, moved up outside on the backstretch, raced four wide around the final turn then continued evenly through the lane. CURE was unhurried two wide, swung out entering the stretch and finished fast outside. HALTON GULLY was slow early, made a wide run around the final turn but failed to sustain through the lane. TRIBUTE wasn't far back when caught in tight quarters between horses on the backstretch and into the far turn then flattened out in the lane. NEBIKON moved up between horses on the backstretch, raced three wide around the final turn then tired. YOU'RE NO SAINT moved to vie outside the winner before a half, raced two wide around the final turn then stopped in the lane. DRAYTON HALL was outrun. EL PICHON stopped inside. ZIPREME made the early pace along the rail and was finished before a half.
