ROCKY ROMANO was unhurried, stayed out from the rail around the turn, took over from the inside after five furlongs and drove clear. CHEOPS showed speed between horses, took over two wide midway on the turn but couldn't contain the winner. QUITE A LEGACY settled, raced three wide between horses around the turn and lacked a strong closing. COUNTRY RISK raced three wide around the turn and made up ground between horses late. MILES LONG GONE was slow early then made a late run inside. ONE TIME RICHIE rallied the rail around the turn came out to vie into the final furlong then tired. PLEASURE BOAT lagged badly following a slow break then failed to menace with a mild late run. SANTA was close up between horses early then tired. CALL IN RICH was outrun inside. PORTLAND POINT was close up outside early, was fanned wide on the turn and stopped. TATAO'S WIDCAT moved clear from the inside on the backstretch, remained in control into the turn and stopped in the stretch.
