Footnotes

JOEY N took command at once, stayed out from the inside once clear on the turn and was under steady handling. CHIEF CARLSON moved up outside early, raced the three path around the turn and couldn't gain in the lane. FOR SCIPION was put in tight and bumped between horses early on the backstretch, made a wide run on the turn then flattened out. ITS A PRIVILEGE came out early on the backstretch and caused crowding then weakened. TRUE COMPASS was slow early, came out on the turn and gained mildly in the lane. JAMBONIED clipped heels and stumbled when put in tight between horses early on the backstretch causing the rider to nearly fall off then recovered and continued evenly. Objections by Wolfsont against the first three finishers were not allowed. IS NOT took outside early on the backstretch, advanced wide on the urn then tired. PROUD TRICK briefly showed speed inside. There was a stewards' inquiry into the events on the backstretch but the results stood.
