**Footnotes**

MINE N GEMS moved up inside early to press the pace, drew out entering the stretch and held under steady left hand whip. TRUE HEAVEN lagged early, bore out on the turn, was wide into the stretch and finished full of run. BRITESUNNYSKY wasn't far back between horses early, stayed out from the rail around the turn and tired in the lane. ZIPREME took command at once, made the pace two wide for over a half, ran out entering the stretch then tired. COUNTRY RISK was slow early then passed tired ones. FAVORITE PATRIOT pressed outside the early leader, was carried wide by that one into the stretch and stopped. CROSSEYED was close up between rivals early, stayed out from the inside around the turn then stopped in the lane.
