BEAR'S COWBOY steadied along the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, stayed inside around the turn, came out for the drive and finished with a late rush. BOSS MAN SUE stayed well out from the inside while not far back to the stretch then tired. SIXTEEN STONE bumped with MIDNIGHT WIND at the break then was slow early and made a belated run outside. STELIOS was no factor. LIMESTONE COWBOY broke slowly then lagged into the final furlong. RIOT SQUAD tired inside. MIDNIGHT WIND bumped with SIXTEEN STONE at the break, dueled early, steadied while bearing out nearing the stretch and stopped. THAT'S THE GAFF swung wide into the stretch and stopped.
