SHE AIN'T BAD had position outside, bid three wide on the turn, drew out before five furlongs and was under urging. WINNING FOR SARAH settled inside, came out four wide midway on the turn while rallying and finished willingly outside. EPIC STORY ducked out into CURLY W leaving the gate then was slow early, raced two wide into the stretch, angled out and finished with good energy. PINK PRINCESS set or forced the pace two wide to the stretch then weakened. PAMPAS ANGEL raced two wide between rivals around the turn and lacked a closing. RAGING SMOKE moved up three wide between rivals on the turn then flattened out in the lane. WINTER LADY dueled inside for about a half then tired. MY TEE TIME wasn't far back between rivals early, angled to the rail on the turn then tired. CURLY W was bumped from both sides leaving the gate then was outrun. OUR QUIET DANCER came in on CURLY W leaving the gate then trailed.
