SEEKER wasn't far back between horses, was in tight four wide nearing the stretch then weakened. HALTON GULLY came well out from the inside while trailing on the backstretch then passed tired ones in the lane. STARSHIP CAPTAIN was hustled early between horses, was in tight three wide nearing the stretch then tired. TRIDENT HERO took over midway on the backstretch, stayed out from the inside on the turn and stopped in the lane.
